

Sunday Readings

<u>First Reading</u>: (Deuteronomy 4:1-2, 6-8) The gift of the law, which we hear God giving to Israel in today's First Reading, is fulfilled in Jesus' Gospel, which shows us the law's true meaning and purpose (see <u>Matthew</u> 5:17).

Second Reading: (Ja mes 1:17-18, 21-22, 27) Israel, by its observance of the law, was meant to be an example to surrounding nations. As James tells us in today's Epistle, the Gospel was given to us that we might have new birth by the Word of truth. By living the Word we've received, we're to be examples of God's wisdom to those around us, the "first fruits" of a new humanity.

Tradition of Fighting

There is a story about a young, newly ordained priest who went to serve his first church. The young priest thought this was a bit odd, but he kept going in the prayers until he began to hear some murmuring between the two sides, then the murmuring turned into grumbling and then people yelling at each other, each side proclaiming that THEY were doing the right thing when it came to the tradition of the church.

To which the old priest responded, "No, that's not the tradition either."

The young priest threw his hands in the air in exasperation, and said, "There must be some solution to this! The way things are now, half stand and half sit and all end up screaming at one another during the prayers."

The old priest's face lit up in a smile; he lifted his finger high into the air and said, "Ahh, yes! Now I remember—that was the tradition!"
