

# **Sunday Readings**

**First Reading:** (Isaiah 42: 1-4, 6-7) Jesus is the chosen servant Isaiah prophesies in today's First Reading, anointed with the Spirit to make things right and just on earth. God puts His Spirit upon Jesus to make Him "a covenant of the people," the liberator of the captives, the light to the nations.

**Second Reading:** (Acts 10:2-34-38) Jesus, today's Second Reading tells us, is the One long expected in Israel, "anointed . . . with the Holy Spirit and power."

**Gospel:** (Luke 3:15-16,21-22) The prophets taught Israel to await a royal offshoot of David, upon whom the Spirit would rest (see <u>Isaiah 11:1-</u>2; <u>Daniel 9:25</u>). That's why the crowds are so anxious at the start of today's Gospel. But it isn't John they're looking for. God confirms with His own voice what the angel earlier told Mary: Jesus is the Son of the Most High, come to claim the throne of David forever (see <u>Luke 1:32-33</u>).

Discover a world beyond massmarket like *Monopoly, Sorry!*, and *Uno*. Modern-day board games rely less on a lucky roll of the


dice or the flip of a card, and more on good design that rewards thoughtful analysis and good decisions. These games can be a good alternative to chess, cribbage, or bridge.

# **Did Jesus have to be baptized?**

The question of whether Jesus had to be baptized is a complex theological issue that has been explored by various Church teachings and scholars throughout history. While Jesus did not require baptism for the forgiveness of sins, His decision to undergo baptism carries significant meaning.

# The Nature of Jesus' Baptism

- 1. Baptism of Repentance: The baptism administered by John the Baptist was a baptism of repentance, intended for the forgiveness of sins. However, Jesus, being sinless, had no need for repentance or forgiveness. This raises the question of why He chose to be baptized at all. The Catechism of the Catholic Church clarifies that Jesus' baptism was not for His own purification but rather an act of solidarity with humanity. By participating in this ritual, He identified with those who were seeking repentance and conversion.
- **2. Fulfillment of Righteousness:** In the Gospel of Matthew, when John the Baptist expresses his reluctance to baptize Jesus, the Lord responds, "Let it be so now; for thus it is fitting for us to fulfill all righteousness" (Matthew 3:15). This statement indicates that Jesus' baptism was part of His mission to fully embrace God's will. It was an act of obedience and a demonstration of His commitment to the divine plan of salvation.

# Theological Significance

- 1. Nauguration of His Ministry: Jesus' baptism marks the beginning of His public ministry. It is a moment of divine revelation, where the Holy Spirit descends upon Him, and the voice of the Father proclaims Him as His beloved Son (Matthew 3:17). This event signifies the anointing of Jesus for His mission and the establishment of His identity as the Messiah.
- **2. Prefiguration of His Death:** Jesus' baptism also foreshadows His passion and death. The act of being immersed in water symbolizes His future immersion in suffering and sacrifice for the sins of humanity. Pope John Paul II noted that Jesus' baptism contains a redemptive intention, as He is "the Lamb of God, who takes away the sin of the world" (John 1:29). Thus, His baptism is intrinsically linked to His ultimate sacrifice on the Cross.
- In conclusion, while Jesus did not need to be baptized in the sense of requiring forgiveness of sins, His baptism was a deliberate and meaningful act. It served to fulfill all righteousness, inaugurate His public ministry, and prefigure His redemptive mission. By choosing to be baptized, Jesus demonstrated His solidarity with humanity and His commitment to the divine will, setting an example for all believers.
